

## **What to Expect when you return to Oakcrest Church of Christ Sunday services beginning June 7<sup>th</sup>**

Sunday Morning worship services will resume June 7, 2020 at 10:00 a.m., however, "*live streaming*" of services will continue and individuals with underlying health concerns as well as those who are caring for individuals with underlying health issues are strongly encouraged to use caution and stay at home.

There will be no Sunday Morning Bible Classes or nursery care until otherwise notified. Activity packets for children will be available.

Entrances to and exits from the building will be restricted to the two southside entrances and the westside entrance for the handicapped.

Entrances to and exits from the auditorium will be restricted to the east and west main auditorium doors (center door will be blocked) and the west side auditorium door.

The north hallway and part of the east hallway where the children classes are located will be off-limits. Restrooms on the west and east side only will be open. All water fountains will be restricted.

Upon entry to the building, we will have check-in stations set up to check temperatures, provide hand sanitizer, and disposable masks which will be available for those who need one. Individuals with a temperature over 100.4 degrees will be asked to return home.

For those over the age of two (2), masks will be required upon entry and departure, however, they can be removed during services.

Members will be seated every other aisle and spacing of 6 feet between, except for family members is strongly encouraged.

Singing will be from the screens only as songbooks will be removed from the auditorium

Communion will be handled differently and may vary from week to week. For week one members will pick up their individual communion packet at the check-in desk when they enter. Week two will most likely involve communion stations where members are asked to file by and pick up their individual bread and juice.

Contribution containers will be set up at the three auditorium entrances/exits.

In all cases, members are being asked to follow the most current CDC guidelines for public worship assemblies. This includes wearing masks when around groups of people, refraining from hugging and shaking hands, and attempting to maintain the 6-foot distancing recommendations. Weather permitting, socializing outside the building is encouraged.

**In the event an individual tests positive for COVID-19 within 14 days of attending any service at Oakcrest they are asked to notify the church office as soon as possible in order to properly notify others who may have been exposed.**
